The name of the dog and all of the details as recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the committee of the Kennel Club.  
ALL dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by the Kennel Club. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name  
A puppy under six calendar months of age cannot be exhibited.

**DECLARATION**

I/We undertake to abide by the Regulations of this Show and not to bring any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the Show or to bring any dog which has been prepared for exhibition contrary to Kennel Club Rules and Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (Annex B). I/We agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the Kennel Club. I/We further declare that I/We believe to the best of my/our knowledge that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Show Regulations

## Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (Annex B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule 42 A.
  - a. A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - b. Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties or either a fine or listed under Rule 42 A.
2.
  - a. No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at the time of the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
  - b. Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
  - a. Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - b. The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
  - c. Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are show.Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of a dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

**DOG FOULING AND GROOMING WASTE (ANIMAL).** Any owner, exhibitor or other person in charge if a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) and /or any grooming waste at Kennel Club licenced shows within the licenced venue and within the environs of that event, including car and caravan parks ar approaches. The chalking, powdering or spraying (with the exception of water) of exhibitors within the precincts of the show is forbidden.

### DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused

### WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dogs(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default or omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for Disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.  
Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
