INSTRUCTIONS

 ALL dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by the Kennel Club. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name
 A puppy under six calendar months of age cannot be exhibited. When entering more than one breed or variety use, if possible, a separate form for each.

I/We agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the Kennel Club. I/We further declare that I/We believe to the best of my/our knowledge that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Show Regulations
